

Dispensary service

At Budbrooke, we have an onsite dispensary service, where we dispense patients their acute medication after their appointment such as the contraceptive pill.



In addition to this, patients can collect their repeat prescriptions from the dispensary or set up electronically to collect from a local chemist if they prefer.

Making an appointment without a parent You can do this!

When a doctor is trying to decide whether a child is mature enough to make decisions, they often talk about if they are 'Gillick Competent'. This is based on medical law and is used to decide whether a child (under 16 years of age) is able to consent to his or her own medical treatment, without the need for parental permission or knowledge. For example if you wish to speak to a doctor or nurse about contraception please make an appointment with reception.

Maintaining Confidentiality

To maintain confidentiality, please ensure we have your telephone numbers on your records instead of your parents. We can then contact YOU about your care if you wish. If you prefer for your parents to manage your medical records that is fine, please let us know. If you have an email address, please also update this to ensure we can contact you on email.

At Budbrooke we offer Online Patient Access where patients can book and cancel appointments, order prescriptions and view their medical record online. This should be for your use only, therefore, we do not make this available until patients are aged 18 and over.



Confidential GP/ Nurse Services

Under the Data Protection Act 1998 and the Human Rights Act 1998, all of the information given in your consultation is held in confidence. We offer private consultation rooms where our clinicians provide reassurance and build a patient's confidence and trust. We always try and offer for you to see your preferred GP to provide a continuity of care.



Contraception

We offer a range of contraception options here at Budbrooke. Our nurses can consult you regarding contraceptive pills and depo injections .



Blood clinics

You can book an appointment for a blood test with the HCA during their clinic times. We can do blood tests at the surgery for 16+ year old patients. We ask that you phone up for your own results to maintain confidentiality.

Long term conditions

We provide advice to and perform assessments on our young patients with asthma and diabetes. If you have a long term condition it is important you book in for your reviews when they are due. This is to ensure you are taking the right medication and are managing your condition appropriately.



Immunisations

Our nurses offer immunisations at the surgery. This includes travel vaccinations and the Meningitis ACWY which is for patients aged 18-25. The vaccination is to prevent teenagers and 'fresher' students going to university for the first time from meningitis and septicemia. Patients which are high risk are able to have their immunisations at our practice. We can also catch up on HPV that have been missed at school .



Weight monitoring

Our nurses offer a confidential weight and monitoring service at the surgery. This can help patients keep on top of their weight, if they are looking to lose weight. Nurses can also refer you to a community programme called Fitter Futures. Ask for more details.

Physiotherapy

You can self-refer yourself to Physio at Warwick Hospital if you are having Back or Neck pain, Recent strain or sprain or joint or muscle pain. Pick up a form from Reception.

Dermatology

If you are worried about a skin problem including acne you can come and see a GP here who will provide treatment for you or refer you to a specialist.



Mental Health

We offer consultations where you can speak to a GP about any worries or concerns you have in confidence. The GP can give you advice about local services and support we can offer in the local area. We now offer MIND appointments at the surgery for patients over 11 years old! Ask at reception to self refer yourself. Good for low stress and anxiety & depression.
