

## SNAP-IV 26-Item teacher and parent rating scale

This questionnaire is a trusted and widely used rating scale to detect possible attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD).

It screens for nine symptoms of ADHD hyperactive-impulsive type, nine symptoms of ADHD inattentive type, and eight symptoms of oppositional defiant disorder. **It should be completed by a child's parent or guardian** and taken to a GP appointment when discussing an ADHD referral.
