

<u>IID3 – New Research Study</u>



The Third Infectious Intestinal Disease Study (IID3 Study) is a national study of gut health to estimate the burden of infectious intestinal disease in general practice and the community. The study is a UK wide collaboration with organisations including the UK Health Security Agency, University of Oxford, University of Liverpool, Liverpool Clinical Laboratories, Public Health Scotland and Public Health Wales.

GPs will ask every patient with gastroenteritis, which presents to the practice to provide a stool sample. This is so that the research project, can calibrate national surveillance systems. The sample will be processed for a wide range of pathogens at Liverpool Clinical Laboratories and the results reported back to us at the practice, which we will then report back to the patient. Remember all patients are consented to participating in research and can opt out at any time!
