COVID Vaccine, RSV Vaccine & Flu Jabs:

Budbrooke Medical Centre will be offering the COVID vaccinations in practice when the autumn campaign for flu jabs is rolled out. This will available for those patients who are eligible.

We will also soon be offering the RSV vaccination. Respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) is an enveloped RNA virus who the same family as the human parainfluenza viruses and mumps and measles viruses. From 1 September 2024, 2 new RSV vaccination programmes will be introduced:

- Programme for older adults aged 75 to 79 years old
- Programme for pregnant women to protect infants.

The practice will be planning in appointments depending on guidance from September, however some cohorts cannot be called out until after the 3rd of October.
